English	Term I	1. Make a colourful name board for your family on a cardboard and decorate it.
		2. Ask the students to draw their favorite animal. Once they finish their drawing, have them write simple sentences or labels about the animal, such as 'The lion is big,' or 'The cat has a tail.'
		3. Write the definitions of Verb, Adverb, Noun, and Pronoun with examples on a chart paper.
	Term II	1. Each student has to create a piece of art using any letter in the English Alphabet, such as drawing items that start with that letter (A – Apple, Ant). They can also decorate the letter to make it colorful and creative.
		2. Ask students to draw shapes (circle, square, triangle) using different colors and then label them with their names. For example, "This is a red circle."
		3. Make a Christmas tree and decorate it.

Mathematics	Term I	1. Students have to cut out various shapes from colored paper (or use pre-cut shapes) and arrange them to form a picture. For example, they could create a house using squares, triangles, and rectangles. Afterward, ask students to identify and label the shapes in their artwork.
		2. By using your thumb print of different colours, show 3 additions and 2 subtractions on an A4 size sheet.
		3. Draw or paste the pictures of cakes of your birthday (from 1 year to present age) with your photo.

G.K.	Term II	1. Make a clock of cardboard and show your happiest time of the day.
		2. Paste the pictures of any 4 seasons on a chart paper and write their names.
		3. Provide students with modeling clay or playdough and ask them to create 3D shapes. They can create a cube, sphere, cylinder, and cone. Afterward, students can label each shape and discuss its properties (e.g., number of faces, edges).
	Term I	1. Ask students to create a family tree by drawing pictures of their family members. They can label each member with their names (e.g., mother, father, brother, etc.) and color the tree. This helps children learn about family relationships and their roles.
		2. Draw or paste pictures of some popular cartoon characters on a chart paper.
		3. Students have to draw a tree and show what it looks like in different seasons (e.g., spring with flowers, summer with green leaves, fall with colourful leaves, and winter with snow). Students can use colours and textures to make each season distinct.
	Term II	1. Paste the pictures of different dances performed in India.
		2. Students have to create a simple model of the solar system using paper or clay. They can paint or color the planets and arrange them in order around the Sun on a piece of cardboard.
		3. Write the names of currencies from different countries and draw their symbols and flags on a chart paper.
